A Day We Celebrate as the Body of Christ

On Sunday, June 18, Catholics in the United States celebrate the *Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ*. We used to call it the Feast of Corpus Christi ("Body of Christ"), a feast that celebrates Jesus' gift of himself in the Eucharist. The feast originated in France in the mid-thirteenth century and was extended to the whole Church by Pope Urban IV in 1264. In much of the world, it is celebrated on the Thursday following Trinity Sunday. In the United States it is celebrated on the Sunday following that feast. There are two major themes to this feast: the Body of Christ that is the Holy Eucharist and the Body of Christ that is our communion of faith, the Church. The Church is called the Body of Christ because of the intimate communion which Jesus shares with us, His disciples.

When we gather for Mass, we become one with Christ, transformed by his loving gift. We become one with Christ in the person we may not know sitting next to us in the pew; in the victims of parish bombings while at Mass in Nigeria; in the young Polish students getting ready for World Youth Day; and in the Peruvian children receiving Holy Communion for the first time, singing "Somos el Cuerpo de Cristo"/"We Are the Body of Christ." The feast encourages us to embrace the Eucharistic reality that although we may be strangers sharing the one Lord's table wherever we are, we are one, just as the many grains of wheat make up one loaf of bread, and the many grapes make up the shared wine in the Lord's cup of blessing. Although there are many divisions among Christians in the world today, as ambassadors of Christ, let us pray that God will show us the way to unity through our devotion to Christ in the Eucharist so that we can offer a more genuinely compelling and fruitful witness to a world in need of God's love and compassion.
